Statutory Consultation under section 11A of the Electricity Act 1989 and section 23 of the Gas Act 1986 on the proposed modification to the Funding Return Mechanism (FRM) set out in the Network Innovation Competition (NIC) and Low Carbon Networks Fund (LCNF) licence conditions

Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks (SSEN) welcome the opportunity to respond to the above consultation. Innovation plays an important part in supporting the move to a low carbon economy as well as ensuring that the energy networks are fit to meet the future challenges of the sector. We are proud to actively contribute towards a sustainable energy future and we believe that projects funded through the NIC and the LCNF mechanisms are providing important benefits to customers.

The proposed additions to the FRM have the potential to increase benefits to customers further and we do not oppose the subsequent licence modification. However, we believe that further clarity is required, particularly relating to already ongoing projects, as SSEN is currently undertaking projects expected to earn revenue. It is our expectation that greater detail is included in and consulted on in the NIC and LCNF guidance documents. We will comment further at that time.
