DECISION FOLLOWING AN APPLICATION FOR APPEAL MADE TO THE AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO REGULATION 70(1)(a) OF THE ELECTRICITY CAPACITY REGULATIONS 2014 (AS AMENDED) (THE "REGULATIONS")

Limejump Ltd submitted an appeal notice to the Authority on 18 November 2016 pursuant to Regulation 70(2) relating to the Prequalification Decision by National Grid Electricity Transmission plc in its capacity as Delivery Body in respect of the following Capacity Market Unit:

Pursuant to Regulation 69(1) an affected person can request the Delivery Body to review a reviewable decision and provide a reconsidered decision. Under Regulation 68 a Prequalification Decision is a reviewable decision. Further, under Regulation 70 an affected person can lodge an appeal with Ofgem, only where it has previously made a request of the Delivery Body, and for the purposes of this matter, where it disputes the reconsidered decision. We understand that at the time the appeal was lodged with Ofgem a reconsidered decision had not been made by the Delivery Body. Your appeal does not comply with Regulation 70 and is therefore rejected.
