




ECO2 monitoring consultation

The ECO2 monitoring consultation <u>response</u> has been published.

The proposed changes will take effect from 1 April 2017. A number of the changes depend on government amendments to the ECO legislation which may introduce deemed scores. This now also include the new monitoring questions.

Upcoming publications and events

- In January we will publish the results of the room in roof insulation audit. We have communicated results to suppliers and are working with them to explore options for next steps.
- Following the receipt of new information, we will re-publish the deemed scores in the new year to update all scores relating to electric boilers. In the majority of cases cost scores for replacement electric boilers will be zero. Carbon and cost scores for non-heating measures installed in properties heated by an electric boiler will also be affected.

About ECO

ECO is a government scheme to reduce carbon dioxide emissions from Britain's domestic housing and support people living in fuel poverty by funding energy efficiency improvements.

It places legal obligations on larger energy suppliers to deliver energy efficiency measures to domestic premises in Great Britain. The scheme began in 2013, and the overall obligation period for the second phase of ECO (ECO2) runs from 1 April 2015 to 31 March 2017.

Ofgem E-Serve is the administrator of ECO while BEIS is responsible for the policy. You can read about Ofgem's role on the scheme on our <u>website</u>.
