Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the proposed modifications to the Regulatory Instructions and Guidance (RIGs). The suggested changes help to clarify the reporting requirements in their respective areas.

As a point for consideration in a wider context, we believe that the volume of reporting required by the entire RIGs package is unduly onerous and is at a level of granularity that is greater than required to serve the purpose of reporting on activities. As part of your Forward Work Programme, we believe there is merit in giving renewed consideration to the content and scope of the RIGs with a view to reducing their size and complexity.
