Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the special conditions of the gas transporters licences held by the licensees above

- The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority')₁ proposes to modify Special Condition 2E (The Network Innovaton Allowance) of the Gas Transporter (NTS) Licence held by National Grid Gas Plc and Special Condition 1H (The Network Innovation Allowance) of the Gas Transporters Licences held by the other licensees listed above, granted or treated as granted under section 7 of the Gas Act 1986.
- 2. We are proposing these modifications to implement our policy decision of 31 March 2017 that licensees should not be able to recover the cost of preparing submissions in respect of projects which pass the Network Innovation Competition initial screening process in 2018/19 and thereafter.2
- 3. The effect of these proposed modifications is to reduce to zero the amount licensees can recover as Bid Preparation Costs in 2018/19 and thereafter.
- 4. The proposed modifications are set out in Appendices to this notice. A copy of the proposed modifications and other documents referred to in this Notice have been published on our website (www.ofgem.gov.uk). Alternatively they are available from our Research and Information Centre, 9 Millbank, London, SW1P 3GE (020 7901 7003).
