### 1.6. Meeting Minutes

### Item 1: Opening remarks

- 1. Rob Salter-Church (Ofgem) opened the PNSG by welcoming attendees and confirming the meeting agenda.
- 2. Rob Salter-Church referenced the arrival of 'Go Live' day and stated that PNSG slides would be circulated following the meeting.

### Item 2: Industry Transition Dashboard

- 1. Phil Russ (PwC) presented the Transition Dashboard and summarised performance in the areas below;
  - Overview of Industry Progress summary as at 12:30 p.m. on 01 June 17
  - Cutover Rag Status of Market Participants, in particular I&C 7 who has not been able to cutover successfully and is manually processing incoming files
  - Summary of cumulative planned vs actual performance

#### **Item 3: Xoserve Cutover**

- 1. Lee Foster (Xoserve) presented the 'External Dashboard for PNSG Cutover' available on the Xoserve website and highlighted the key messages below;
  - Overall plan execution remains Green; PNID has been successfully achieved
  - Data Activities: Delta 2, Delta 3, Delta 4, iGT and GT In-flights, bulk Unique Sites, Custom Tables and In-flight activities (including Data Validation activities) have now concluded to plan
  - SAP BW Extraction and Load continues to progress to plan
  - The first AAQ/MDS file from SAP ISU has been generated and successfully loaded into Gemini
  - All Gemini and CMS deployments have been completed successfully in readiness for Go-live
  - Legacy UK Link activities are progressing to plan
  - All final SAP ISU Configurations have been completed in readiness for Go-live
  - The Bulk AES & IIL files has been issued to all stakeholders to plan
