12.2.1B A report under Rule 12.2.1 must also be submitted every March 15th and September 15th for the first year after winning an agreement. The first report in such case should be no earlier than eight weeks after winning the Capacity Agreement and the schedule reverts to that under 12.2.1 for the 5th construction report for the relevant CMU; but in relation to these additional reports...
