I am generally very happy with your forward work program. However, I believe that the domestic RHI is not enough of an incentive to encourage domestic investment. I believe that it should last for twenty years just like the non-domestic RHI.

For a real joined up approach to climate change, I strongly suggest that OFGEM should take over the administration and policy development for Feed-in Tariffs for domestic solar photo-voltaic electricity generation because it is being handled in a piecemeal and haphazard way by some of the electricity supply companies, especially some of the newer ones. Further, the Feed-in Tariff is continually reducing killing the incentive for domestic users to invest in this form of electricity generation when the potential for massively increasing this form is being so neglected. Indeed a real drive for this form of generation must be made as it could make a major contribution to the UK energy requirements. Every house in the country should have to have PVs by Law, in my opinion, and regulated by OFGEM alone.
