12.2.1 The Capacity Provider of any Prospective CMU must, no less frequently than every six months from the ~~date of the Capacity Auction~~ 1<sup>st</sup> June after a Capacity Market Agreement has been awarded until such time as the Substantial Completion Milestone is achieved, or the Capacity Agreement terminates or a Non-completion Notice is issued, deliver to the Delivery Body a progress report specifying, for each Generating Unit or Electricity Interconnector comprising such CMU:
