Preparing for EU Exit: statutory consultation on consequential licence modifications in the event the UK leaves the EU without a deal

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above statutory consultation, dated 14 January 2019. This response should be regarded as a consolidated response on behalf of UK Power Networks' affected distribution licence holding companies: Eastern Power Networks plc; London Power Networks plc; and South Eastern Power Networks plc.
