Dear Company Secretary,

Direction under Standard Condition A2 (Application of Section C) to have the standard conditions in Section C switched on in the transmission licence of National Grid Electricity System Operator Limited (NGESO).

This letter directs under paragraph 2 of Standard Licence Condition A2 (Application of Section C) that the standard conditions in Section C shall have effect in NGESO's transmission licence.

The Direction comes into effect from 1 April 2019 to coincide with the partial transfer of National Grid Electricity Transmission's (NGET) electricity transmission licence to NGESO.

Background

In January 2017, BEIS, Ofgem and National Grid issued a joint statement¹ which stated that a more independent Electricity System Operator (ESO) could realise benefits for consumers by enabling a more competitive and flexible system. The statement set out our joint views that the ESO should be underpinned by a governance structure that mitigates any actual or perceived conflicts of interest, and is ready to adapt further as system challenges continue to evolve. The statement recognised that a more independent ESO would need to be underpinned by impartial governance. The joint statement also recognised that greater ESO independence could increase consumer benefits through a greater focus on transparency, markets and competition.

In December 2017, we published a consultation document providing detail on how we expect to implement the legal separation of the ESO from NGET². This set out our thinking on how we expect NGET's electricity transmission licence to be split into two separate electricity transmission licences – an NGET TO licence and an ESO licence.

NGET submitted its formal application to transfer part of its existing transmission licence to the new ESO entity in March 2018. We consulted on the proposed partial transfer of the transmission licence held by National Grid Electricity Transmission and the associated

licence modifications required to separate the ESO functions³ and published our decision on 4 September 2018.⁴

Direction

The Authority directs under paragraph 2 of Standard Condition A2 (Application of Section C) that the standard conditions in Section C, transferred to NGENSO and coming into effect on 1 April 2019, shall have effect in NGENSO's transmission licence from 1 April 2019.

This Direction is being made in order to reflect the new arrangements that will be in place once NGENSO takes over the electricity system operator functions from NGET.

From the 1 April 2019 NGENSO's standard licence conditions under Part II will therefore consist of:

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- Section A. Interpretation, Application and Payments
- Section B. General
- Section C. System Operator Standard Conditions

This decision constitutes notice pursuant to section 49A of the Electricity Act 1989
