VARIATION TO THE DIRECTION ISSUED BY THE GAS AND ELECTRICITY MARKETS AUTHORITY TO THE HOLDER OF THE SMART METER COMMUNICATION LICENCES ON 9 March 2017 WHEREAS

- 1. The Authority varies the direction made pursuant to paragraph 10 of condition 36 of the conditions of the smart meter communication licence granted under sections 7AB(2) and (4) of the Gas Act 1986 and sections 6(1A) and (1C) of the Electricity Act 1989.
- 2. The company to whom this direction is addressed ("the licensee") holds the smart meter communication supply licences granted, or treated as granted, pursuant to sections 7AB(2) and (4) of the Gas Act 1986 and sections 6(1A) and (1C) of the Electricity Act 1989 in which condition 36 (Determination of Licensee's Allowed Revenue) has effect ("the licence").
- 3. Paragraph 9 of condition 36 of the licence provides that the total amount of the licensee's Centralised Registration Service Revenue (CRSR) will be calculated for Regulatory Year t in accordance with the following formula:

$$CRSR_t = CRSEC_t + CRSIC_t + CRSPC_t + CRSCA_t + CRSPA_t$$

- 4. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ("the Authority") has the power pursuant to paragraph 10 of condition 36 of the licence to amend the value of the term "CRSPA_t", which would otherwise be zero.
- 5. On 16th October 2018¹, the Authority consulted on the contents of this amendment direction and has carefully considered the responses to that consultation.

NOW THEREFORE

6. The Authority hereby directs that the value of CRSPA_t shall be as set out in the schedule to this direction.

- 7. This variation to the direction issued on 9 March 2017 extends the CRSPA term to cover DCC's role within the Design, Build and Test Phase of the Programme as set out in the October 2018 consultation₁. The variation defines and differentiates between the original CRSPA term for the Transitional Phase and the additional CRSPA term for the Design, Build and Test Phase of the Programme.
- 8. This direction shall take effect on 31 May 2019 and shall continue until revoked or amended by the Authority following a period of consultation with the licensee for not less than 28 days, beginning on the date of notice of the revocation or amendment, or such other period as may be agreed in writing by the Authority and the licensee, during which representations with respect to the proposed revocation or amendment may be made.

- 9. This direction outlines the performance related revenue that the licensee can expect in remuneration for its role in delivering the CRS. This takes the form of a rate of return applied to internal costs and is placed at risk through incentivised milestones.
- 10. The following documents constitute notice pursuant to section 38A (Reasons for decisions) of the Gas Act 1986 and section 49A (Reasons for decisions) of the Electricity Act 1989:

SCHEDULE

Value of CRSPAt

1. The value of CRSPAt shall be calculated according to the following formula:

$$CRSPA_t = CRSPAT_t + CRSPAD_t$$

Where:

The performance adjustment term for the Transitional Phase of the Switching Programme (CRSPAT) is:

$$CRSPAT_t = 13.6\% * (CRSICT_t - TM1_t - TM2_t - TM3_t + R_t)$$

This is unchanged in this amendment from the March 2017 direction apart from amendments in terminology to further clarify and differentiate the two phases.

And

The performance adjustment term for the Design, Build and Test ('DBT') Phase of the Switching Programme (CTSPAD) is:

$$CRSPAD_t = 13.6\% * (CRSICD_t - DM1_t - DM2_t - DM3_t - DM4_t - DM5_t + DRM_t) + DDR_t$$

This is additional to this amended direction and was not covered in the March 2017 direction.

Interpretation

- 2. Unless a contrary intention appears, any reference to terms in this direction is to be read to have the same meaning given in the licence.
- 3. Differences between forecast and allowed margin will be adjusted through subsequent price control (t+1).
- 4. In this direction:

As applied to the Transitional Phase of the Switching Programme under the $CRSPAT_t$ term
