Invitation to Supply Licensing Review stakeholder workshop on 21 June 2019

In November 2018, we published a consultation on our approach to licensing and regulating suppliers, to raise standards around suppliers' financial resilience and customer service.¹ We would like to invite you to attend a workshop on the ongoing and exit stages of this review, which we will hold at Ofgem 10 South Colonnade, Canary Wharf, London, E14 4PU.

The purpose of this workshop is to hear your views on a number of options we are considering for increasing our ongoing scrutiny and oversight of suppliers already operating in the retail energy markets. We will also discuss how we might improve arrangements for managing supplier exit.

We will publish a working paper later this month. This paper aims to update stakeholders on our current thinking and set out key discussion points for the workshop.
