**Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to insert new special conditions into the electricity interconnector licence held by National Grid IFA 2 Limited**

1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (the **Authority**)<sup>1</sup> proposes to modify the electricity interconnector licence held by National Grid IFA 2 Limited (**NGIFA2**) granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(e) of the Electricity Act 1989 by inserting into that licence 11 proposed new special conditions, as specified in Schedule 1A of this notice.
2. We are proposing these modifications in order to give effect to our July 2018 decision<sup>2</sup> on the Final Project Assessment of the IFA2 interconnector (the **IFA2 FPA**).
3. The effect of the proposed modifications is to implement NGIFA2's cap and floor regime and reflect the NGIFA2's specific elements of the cap and floor regime that are contained in the July 2018 decision.
4. Specific details on the reasons for, and effects of, the proposed modifications can be found in Schedule 1B of this notice.
5. Further details and background on these proposed licence modifications are set out in the IFA2 FPA.
