Dear Mr. Marr,

GNI (UK) Limited ("GNI (UK)") welcomes the opportunity to respond to the Statutory consultation on consequential licence modifications due to the end of the Transition Period and furthermore welcomes the steps taken by Ofgem to ensure a smooth exit of the UK from the European Union as we approach the end of the Transition Period.

We note that the proposed modifications "do not seek to change the current obligations and duties of licensees, nor do they seek to change current policy positions" but rather ensure that licences accurately reflect retained EU law and will continue to function effectively from January 1st 2021 onwards.

Having reviewed the proposed modifications, GNI (UK) shares the understanding that current obligations and duties of GNI (UK) will not change. Consequently, we have no further comments on the proposed modifications within the consultation document.
