Dear Stakeholder,

Non-Domestic Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) Environmental Permitting Regulatory Position Statement (RPS)

On 26 February Ofgem published an open letter¹ explaining our proposed administrative approach to dealing with RHI accreditation application where the applicant is operating their plant under the 'Medium combustion plant (MCP) section 5.1 Part B new permits: RPS 244'.

We have been made aware that that some applicants may be operating their plant under 'Specified generator and medium combustion plant new bespoke permits: RPS 243'², while the Environment Agency (EA) is determining their application for an environmental permit (EP).

This letter confirms that Ofgem's proposed approach, set out in our letter of 26 February, will also apply to RHI accreditation applications where the applicant is operating their plant under RPS 243.
