Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to modify the Special Conditions of the electricity transmission licence held by each of the above licensees

1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority')¹ proposes to modify the electricity transmission licence held by each of the above licensees ("the licensees"), granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(b) of the Electricity Act 1989 by
 - a. amending the existing Special Conditions including the Price Control Financial Instruments; and
 - b. inserting new Special Conditions.
2. We are proposing these modifications to improve the clarity of the licence and ensure proper implementation of our RIIO-2 Final Determinations for Transmission companies and the System Operator.
3. The reasons and effects of the proposed modifications, together with the full text of the proposed modifications are published alongside this notice on our website,² alternatively they are available from foi@ofgem.gov.uk.
4. In addition, further details and background on the licences and the RIIO-2 price control are set out in the following documents:
