Schedule of correspondence between Ofgem and Symbio with regard to its payment obligations.

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Correspondence between Ofgem and Symbio

Date	Correspondence	
18 December 2019	Email from Ofgem to Symbio advising that	
	mutualisation had been triggered and therefore it	
	required to make certain quarterly payments under	
	the RO scheme. The email attached a schedule noting	
	the dates on which payment was due.	
6 May 2020	Letter from Ofgem to all relevant suppliers (including	
	Symbio) summarising key dates and actions with	
	regard to payment obligations under the RO scheme.	
28 May 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio noting that it had not	
	received a response to the letter of 6 May confirming	
	how Symbio expects to meet its RO Payment for	
	2019- 2020. The email calls for a response by no later	
	than 29 May 2020.	
29 May 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem indicating that Symbio is	
	confident that it will be in a position to make the RO	
	Payment by 31 August 2020. It does highlight that	
	the situation caused by Covid-19 has increased its bad	
	debt provisions. Symbio indicates that it had asked	
	Ofgem to put in place a payment plan but then	
	reiterates "we are in a position to meet the payment	
	obligation for RO as per the given deadlines set by	
	Ofgem".	



28 July 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio reminding it that the
	levelisation payment for FIT 1 Payment is due on 11
	August 2020.
5 August 2020	Email and letter from Ofgem to Symbio reminding it
	of its obligations with regard to the RO scheme.
10 August 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio noting that its
	levelisation payment for the FIT 1 Payment is due the
	next day (11 August 2020) and that Ofgem has not
	yet received payment.
12 August 2020	Letter from Ofgem to Symbio (sent via email) noting
	that Symbio has not complied with its obligation to the
	FIT 1 Payment.
13 August 2020 (timed	Email from Symbio to Ofgem questioning the amount
at 19:03)	due and citing that query as the reason that Symbio
	has not made payment. Symbio does not cite
	cashflow problems caused by Covid-19.
13 August 2020 (timed	Email from Ofgem to Symbio answering Symbio's
at 16:42)	query with regard to the amount due and confirming
	that the sum is now late and has been referred to
	Ofgem's enforcement team for consideration.
26 August 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio reminding it of its RO
	Payment obligations.
28 August 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio reminding it that the RO
	Payment is due by 31 August 2020.
31 August 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio noting that it has made
	a part buy-out payment for the RO Payment and that
	it assumes that the remainder will be made by late
	payment but asking for confirmation.
8 September 2020	Letter from Ofgem to Symbio requesting "robust
	assurance" that Symbio would be in a position to
	make payment of the RO Payment and FIT 2 payment
	on time.
9 September 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio reminding it of its
	obligation to make the RO Payment by the late



	revenue deadling of 21 October 2020. The latter		
	payment deadline of 31 October 2020. The letter		
	notes that failure to do so could trigger enforcement		
	action.		
9 September 2020	Email from the Deputy Director of enforcement at		
	Ofgem to Symbio confirming that it will issue a Notice		
	of Proposal of Final Order on Friday of that week.		
9 September 2020	Email from Symbio to the Deputy Director of		
	enforcement at Ofgem reiterating that it disputes the		
	level of the FIT 1 Payment and indicating that it		
	considers that Ofgem's actions are "abusive".		
10 September 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio replying to its previous		
	emails regarding the FIT 1 Payment.		
10 September 2020	Letter from Ofgem to Symbio formally replying to its		
	complaint with regard to the level of the FIT 1		
	Payment.		
10 September 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem responding to Ofgem		
	having intimated that it intended to issue Notice of		
	Proposal to issue a Final Order in relation to the FIT 1		
	Payment. It confirms that Symbio has now made		
	partial payment of £152,000. It reiterates that		
	Symbio disputes that the remainder is due to be paid		
	and asks Ofgem to confirm that it will not issue the		
	Notice of Proposal of Final Order given the partial		
	payment.		
10 September 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem reiterating that it		
	disputes the total sum due in respect of the FIT 1		
	Payment. This email notes that Symbio considers the		
	threat of enforcement action as disproportionate.		
10 September 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem with regard to		
	anticipated payment of the RO Payment. It also sends		
	draft accounts and notes that the reason for the delay		
	in payment is due to Covid-19 cashflow difficulties.		
11 September 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio asking for clarification		
,	with regard to what Symbio will pay and when.		



11 September 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem clarifying what payments
	it intends to make when and asked for forbearance
	with regard to the RO Payment into November 2020.
	This email reiterates that delays in payment are a
	result of cashflow difficulties caused by Covid-19.
18 September 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio seeking assurances by
	close of business that day that it would make the RO
	Payment on time.
18 September 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem explaining what
	payments it expects to make and when.
21 September 2020	Email from Ofgem to Symbio asking for assurances,
	by close of business the next day, that Symbio will
	make the RO Payment on time or Symbio would face
	enforcement action.
21 September 2020	Email response from Symbio to Ofgem advising that it
	is attempting to make payment but it is having
	cashflow difficulties due to Covid-19.
22 September 2020	Email from Symbio to Ofgem with regard to the RO
	Payment – indicating what it expects to pay and when.
	It states that it will make the RO Payment by 10
	November 2020.
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Telephone calls between Ofgem and Symbio with regard to its payment obligations

Date	Call
11 June 2020	Ofgem and Symbio discussed the RO Payment.
	Symbio explained that it was having cashflow
	difficulties and they discussed the network deferral
	charges scheme. Ofgem made clear that the RO
	Payment must be made on time and that a payment
	plan was not possible.
6 August 2020	Ofgem and Symbio discussed Symbio's cashflow.
	Symbio asked if it was able to make the RO Payment



	in installments. Ofgem confirmed that there was no
	change to usual practices in this regard.
9 September 2020	Symbio explained what it expected to pay toward the
	RO Payment and when. It appears to indicate that it
	will make payment in full by the end of October 2020.
	Symbio reiterates that its biggest cashflow difficulty is
	customer debt collection.
8 October 2020	Symbio indicated that the "worst case" scenario was
	that it would make the RO Payment in full by 10
	November 2020. Symbio asked how they could be
	expected to make the RO Payment given the
	difficulties with customer debt collection. Ofgem
	referred to the other easements in place to support
	suppliers during Covid-19 but stressed that its
	environmental scheme payment obligations were
	mandatory.
23 October 2020	Symbio reiterated its cashflow difficulties due to
	Covid-19

Correspondence from Ofgem to all relevant suppliers with regard to their payment obligations:

Date	Correspondence
2 June 2020	Letter from Ofgem to relevant
	regulated persons setting out the
	schemes available to them to assist
	with cashflow given the policy of
	forbearance on customer debt-
	collection. The letter does not indicate
	that Ofgem can defer sums due under
	the environmental schemes.
16 June 2020	Letter from Ofgem to energy supply
	companies setting out regulatory
	expectations given Covid-19. In the



	Annex, Ofgem make clear that
	suppliers must comply with their
	obligations to make payments under
	the environmental schemes.
17 July 2020	Letter from the Director of Conduct
	and Enforcement to all relevant
	suppliers (including Symbio)
	confirming that Ofgem expects them
	to meet their payment obligations
	under the environmental schemes and
	making clear that it is likely to take
	enforcement action where these
	obligations are not met.
28 August 2020	Letter from the Deputy Director of
	Ofgem to Symbio accompanying letter
	making clear that Ofgem will take
	enforcement action where timely
	payment of RO obligations is not
	made.
