Notice of statutory consultation on a proposal to insert new special conditions into the electricity interconnector licence held by Nemo Link Limited

- 1. The Gas and Electricity Markets Authority ('the Authority')¹ proposes to modify the electricity interconnector licence held by Nemo Link Limited ('Nemo Link') and granted or treated as granted under section 6(1)(e) of the Act by inserting into that licence the proposed new special conditions as specified in Schedule 1A of this notice.
- 2. We are proposing these modifications in order to give effect to our December 2014 decision² to grant Nemo Link a cap and floor regime.
- 3. The effect of the proposed modifications is to implement Nemo Link's cap and floor regime and reflect the Nemo Link specific elements of the cap and floor regime that are contained in the December 2014 decision.
- 4. Specific details on the reasons and effects of the proposed modifications can be found in Schedule 1B of this notice.
- 5. Further details and background on these proposed licence modifications are set out in the following documents:
 - Decision on the cap and floor regime for the GB-Belgium interconnector project Nemo, December 2014; and
 - Our informal consultation on these proposed licence modifications, published on our website on 4 February 2016³.
- 6. Schedule 1C to this notice contains our responses to the issues raised by stakeholders as part of the February 2016 informal consultation on these proposed licence modifications.
