Prepayment meters (PPM) installed under warrant for non-payment of debt	This policy was introduced to protect energy consumers from disproportionate or inappropriate actions or charges throughout the debt recovery process. It introduces a £150 cap on warrant costs that suppliers can recover from domestic consumers. Ofgem considers that consumers, especially those in vulnerable situations, need specific protections against the use of warrants for the force-fitting of prepayment meters and the associated charges.	23.1	RPC-4259(1)-BEIS-OFGEM
