

Renewables Obligation Certificate (ROC) Issue Schedule 2019/2020

Issue Date February 2019

Column A Sets out the dates by which Ofgem must receive monthly import, export and, where appropriate, FMS data from the operator of the generating station for the purposes of issuing ROCs*. If any operator experiences difficulty submitting such data to Ofgem, within the timeframes in this schedule, we should be notified **before** the relevant date in Column A.

Column B Sets out the dates by which Ofgem intends to issue ROCs.

Note: If an operator has problems submitting this data to Ofgem, within the timeframes below, we should be notified **before** the relevant date in Column A. If data for Renewable Obligation Certificates (ROCs) is submitted to Ofgem after the date shown in Column A it will be suspended and Ofgem will look to generators to provide reasons as to why the data was submitted late. In these cases it is unlikely that the ROCs will be issued by the date shown in column B.

** Operators of micro-generating stations i.e. with a **declared net capacity of 50 kW or less** (or their agents) that have notified Ofgem that they want ROCs to be issued on an annual basis, must provide data for gross output and input electricity for the period, 01 April 2019 - 31 March 2020 by 31 May 2020 at the latest.
