Electricity Supply Licence held by URE Energy Limited: revocation pursuant to section 6(8) of the Electricity Act 1989

URE Energy Limited ("the licensee"), (company registration number 10300613), having its registered office at 2-4 Packhorse Road, Gerrards Cross, Buckinghamshire, SL9 7QE, is the holder of an Electricity Supply Licence (the "Licence") granted or treated as granted under Section 6(1)(d) of the Electricity Act 1989 (the "Act"). Section 6(8) of the Act provides that a licence granted or treated as granted under the Act may be revoked in accordance with any term contained in it.

We wrote to the licensee on 1 May 2019 providing written notice by the Authority, pursuant to Schedule 2(1)(c)(i) of the Electricity Supply Licence, of the licensee's failure to comply with the Final Order dated 8th March 2019, namely a failure to pay to the Authority the sum of £209,013.78 owed in relation to the licensee's Renewables Obligation for the year 2017-2018.

In our letter of 1 May we explained that if this failure was not rectified to the satisfaction of the Authority within three months, the Authority may at any time revoke the licensee's Electricity Supply Licence by giving no less than 30 days' notice in writing to the licensee.

The licensee has not rectified the failure to comply with the confirmed Final Order imposed against it by the Authority on 8 March 2019.

Therefore, please find enclosed a notice of revocation of the above licence, giving notice that the licence will be revoked in no less than 30 days.

Subject to consideration of any further relevant issues arising, your licence will be revoked on 14 September 2019.
